RESOLUTION 2017-16 November 28, 2017

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Pierce County Fire Protection District No. 5 as follows:

WHEREAS, the Pierce County Assessor-Treasurer has notified the Commissioners of Pierce County Fire District No. 5 that the assessed valuation of real properties lying within the boundaries of said district for the calendar year 2018 is \$10,494,845,688.00 and

WHEREAS, the Pierce County Fire District #5 has instructed the Assessor-Treasurer to include NC&I in the amount of \$267,877,364.00 for Fire and EMS combined; and

WHEREAS, the attached budget (by this reference made a part of this resolution) be and hereby is adopted as the budget of Pierce County Fire District No. 5 for the calendar year 2018;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that Pierce County is hereby requested to make a levy for the year 2018 for Pierce County Fire District No. 5 of \$20,801.834.32 and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Budget and Finance Department of Pierce County, Washington, be and is hereby authorized and directed to deposit and sequester the moneys received from the collection of the tax levy specified above in the amounts and funds specified below:

A. \$ -0into the Reserve Fund of said District B. \$ -0into the coupon Warrant Fund of said District

into the General Obligation Bond Fund of said District

D. \$15,742,268.53 into the Expense Fund of said District for Fire E. \$5.059,565.79 into the Expense Fund of said District for EMS

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that one copy of this resolution be delivered to the Budget and Finance Department and one copy be delivered to the Office of the Assessor-Treasurer of Pierce County, Washington.
