



## Employment Opportunity: Hydrant Maintenance Laborer

Gig Harbor Fire & Medic One is hiring one candidate to fill the position of Hydrant Maintenance Laborer. This position is seasonal part-time and temporary. We anticipate a start date of June 1, 2022. It is anticipated that this position will last 3-4 months. The laborer will work between 20-40 hours per week, not to exceed 414 hours.

The laborer position pays \$20.00 per hour and is not eligible for benefits.

### **Essential Duties:**

The Laborer will perform hydrant maintenance services. This will be done on a coordinated schedule to provide timely service both to the District and also the water purveyors. Work includes brushing out around hydrants, painting the base color on hydrants, lubing as appropriate, color coding per flow test records, GPS'ing new hydrants, accessing and updating hydrant data on the computer, and completing hydrant records. Work will involve operating a lawn mower, using weed whackers, backpack blower, chainsaw, propane torch, using hand tools, and driving a District vehicle.

The Laborer will work alone and must be aware of the safety hazards associated with driving vehicles, small tool operation, and grounds maintenance equipment.

The position reports to the Prevention Division Chief.

### **Required Qualifications:**

- Minimum of 18 years of age.
- High school graduate or equivalent (GED).
- Must possess and maintain a valid Washington State driver's license.
- Candidates must be tobacco and marijuana free at time of testing.
- Authorized to work in the U.S.
